

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.







SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL RECEIVES \$5,000 GRANT

The St. Vincent de Paul Conference (SVDP) of St. Peter Church is pleased to announce that we have been awarded a \$5,000 grant from Three Rivers Electric Cooperative, to support our mission of providing beds for children.

The St. Vincent de Paul Conference at St. Peter Church was started in 2009 at the request of Bishop Gaydos to our pastor at the time, Father Lammers. The mission of SVDP was to address unmet needs, not just for parish needs, but the community needs as well.

Through the dedication of the SVDP members over the years, and the generosity of our St. Peter parishioners, we have been able to provide and expand our assistance to those in need in many ways. Number one is beds for children. Children need a safe and comfortable area to sleep

in order to do well in school. When a bed is delivered to a home, a prayer is said with the family. This prayer not only provides a peaceful moment in the home, but shows the family that we care about them, and so does Christ.

We try not to duplicate what other agencies can provide, and we work with other agencies to meet the needs of those who come to St. Peter asking for help. We actively work in the community providing volunteer assistance with the Homeless Connect Project, and Jefferson City Room at the Inn. SVDP also provides a monthly community meal at the Salvation Army.

We want to thank our generous parishioners and also Three Rivers Electric Cooperative for recognizing the valuable work of our St. Vincent de Paul conference. Thank you for your continuing generosity and we are always looking for new members to join in our charitable work!






St. Peter Catholic School will be raising funds to help send veterans on the next
