

You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

**DID YOU KNOW?** The largest grade school in the Diocese is Our Lady of Lourdes in Columbia. It is an interparish school with 627 students. Our St. Peter School is the second largest with 490 students. We are proud to be an interparish school as well and your support with stewardship keeps our school running and growing. Thank you.

MONTHLY DIOCESAN TITHE UPDATE: As you know from Fr. Secrist and Fr. Jones our beautiful parish is a part of the Stewardship Cohort 3 along with many other parishes. This means as of July 1, 2023 we pay a monthly 10% tithe on our income. This past week Msgr. Kurwicki delivered the checks for July which was \$25,333 and for August which was \$21,722. As you noticed last weekend we did not take up a special 2nd collection for World Mission Sunday, your donation to the Missions came out of the tithe. Therefore our goal is that the monies you would have given to the Missions you will donate an equal amount to the parish.

This year we will be remembering a native son of this parish, Msgr. Michael Wilbers, who served as a Pastor and Vicar General for many years. *Thanksgiving Day:* There will only be one mass on Thanksgiving Day at 9:00 am. There will be no Mass on the Friday after Thanksgiving. The Parish Office will be closed on November 23 & 24, 2023.


