#### **Holy Matrimony**

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

#### **Baptism**

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

If you are preparing for surgery, please let your priest know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.



#### **ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES**

Staying Healthy during Flu Season: Reminder: the spread of respiratory illnesses such as influenza is mainly person-to-person through coughing or sneezing of infected people.

Everyday actions that can help prevent the spread of germs that cause respiratory illnesses like influenza include: Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it; Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth as germs spread this way; and if you have flu-like symptoms, stay home. The typical illness lasts 5-7 days. The CDC

recommends that you return to school or work when your temperature has been less than 100 degrees for at least 24 hours.

As you do some fall cleaning inside, check your medications and see if you have some out-of -date that are sitting around. For safe disposal, a disposal kiosk is available at Walgreens on Missouri Blvd, Roberts Drug Store on Truman Blvd., Hyvee, and Wal-Mart on Stadium West Blvd If you wish to dispose of your medications yourself, guidelines released by the DEA are available in my office or for additional information visit https://www. deadiversion.usdoj.gov/drug\_disposal/ index.html
