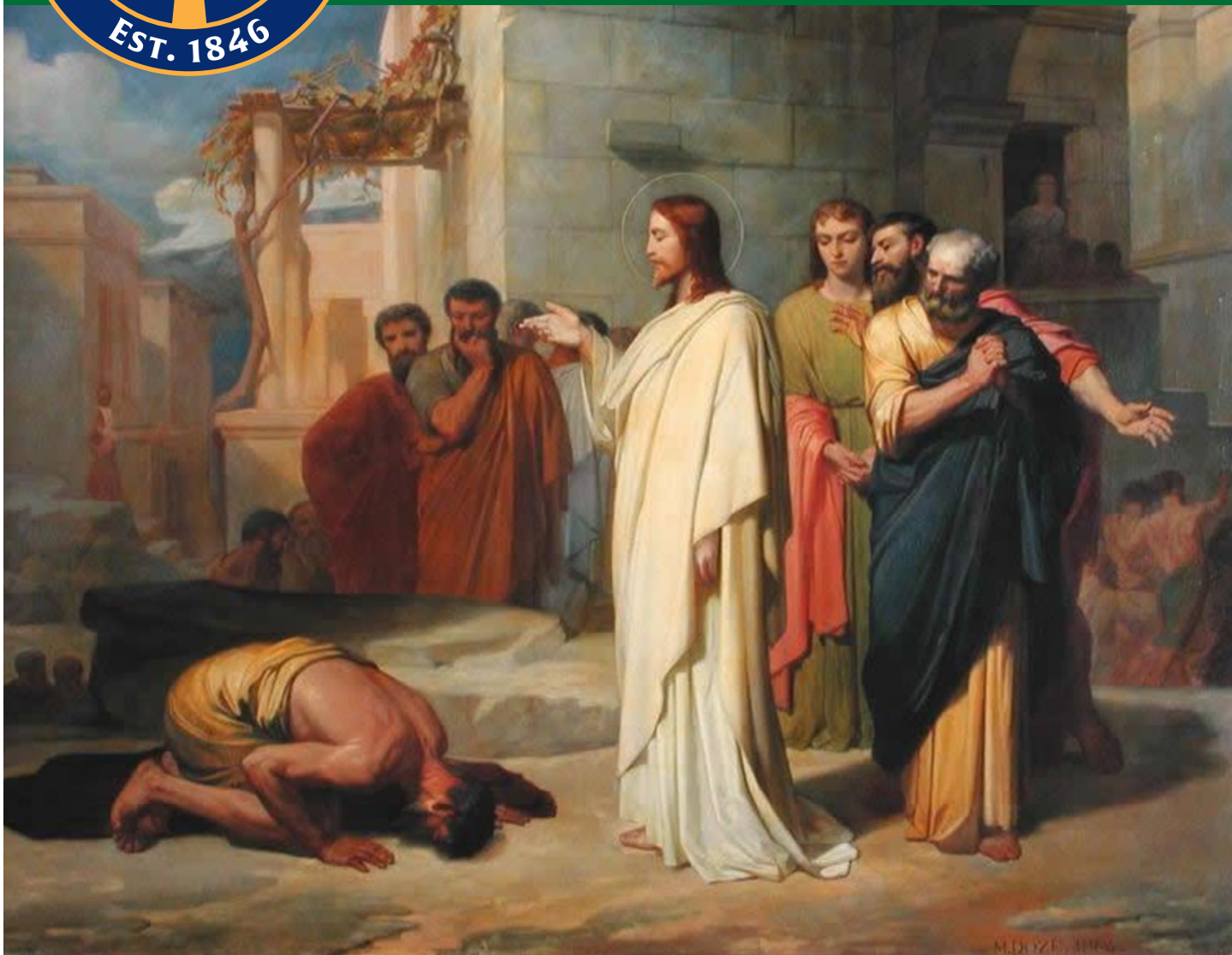

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

Anointing of the Sick

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES

Staying Healthy during Flu Season: The spread of respiratory illnesses such as influenza is mainly person-to-person through coughing or sneezing of infected people. You can help prevent the spread of germs with the following actions: Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze; Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it; Wash your hands frequently with soap and water. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth as germs spread this way; and if you have flu-like symptoms, stay home. The typical illness lasts 5-7 days. Reminder: The U.S. Department of Justice Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) offers a **National Prescription Drug Take-Back Day** twice a year (spring and fall), which aims to provide a safe, convenient, and responsible means of disposing of prescription drugs, while also educating the general public about the potential for abuse and medications. The Next National Prescription Drug Take Back Day is October 29, 2022.

The usual collection sites for this area are from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm at:

- Jefferson City Police Headquarters, 401, Monroe. Use the Training Room entrance on the south side of the building.
- Ashland Police Department, 601 E. Broadway.
- Holts Summit Police Department, 245 S. Summit Dr. #A

A disposal kiosk is also available at Walgreen on Missouri Blvd, Hy-Vee on W. Truman Blvd, Robert's Drug Store on W. Truman, Capital Care Pharmacy on Madison, and Wal-Mart on West Stadium Blvd and on Supercenter Drive.
