

NEW MONTHLY CATHOLIC FORMATION OPPORTUNITY FOR MEN-SIGNUM CRUCIS

Why Signum Crucis? Signum Crucis is Latin for "Sign of the Cross." This new group will focus on growth in the areas of Study, Devotion, and Service. As we trace the Sign of the Cross on our bodies and pray this most basic prayer, we recognize that we need to seek Study for our Minds, seek Devotion in our Hearts, and to wear our faith gained from Study and Devotion on our sleeves in the form of Service.

This group will strongly encourage men to bring their sons to our monthly gatherings. We know how important it is in our current culture to model our faith to our young people before they leave the fold. Therefore, men are especially requested to bring their sons, nephews, and grandsons who are in high school and grade school. By doing this, adult

men will be able to model how to be a true Catholic man by seeking more. This is needed now more than ever.

Monthly gatherings will always be on the third Wednesday of each month, at Helias Catholic High School, from 6:30 p.m. till 8:00 p.m. This timeframe was intentionally set to allow men to get back home in time to help with the family bedtime routine. Our plan is to allow men to choose between attending either a Devotional session or a Study session when we gather, whichever is most needed by each man attending. We might offer a Service opportunity on Wednesday evenings as well. Our Study, Devotion, or Service sessions will last approximately 45-60 minutes, with a wrap-up of our sessions in the Commons, followed by brief fellowship.

Our first gathering will be on September 21. Father Paul Clark, Chaplain of Helias Catholic High School, will offer Mass for us in the Chapel of St. Pius X at Helias at 6:30 p.m. More details about Signum Crucis will be shared after the Mass.

Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.



St. Peter School Counseling News 2022-2023 from Sara Garner

Welcome Back to a new school year! August and September are always a time of new beginnings and discovering your purpose for the coming year. To help students with this task, I begin the year with counseling lessons that focus on how students and their surroundings have changed from last year. We begin class with a discussion about how they have changed and how things may be different in their new classroom. Next students answer some basic questions on a note card about themselves. I keep these from year to year so students can look at them at the beginning of each school year and see how they have changed, or in some cases have stayed the same. Students enjoy sharing these with each other.



September is also when the new group of Student Leaders from 6-8th grade are voted on by their class. Students nominate themselves by filling out an application that helps them define their vision for the school and why they would make a good leader. These applications, not the students' names, are placed on a ballot. This allows voting students to choose whose ideas they like best versus just choosing a name. The Student Leadership Team helps with many school functions throughout the school year as well as raises funds and/or items for various charitable campaigns.

I look forward to watching our students grow from year to year. As the School Counselor, I am available to help students, parents and teachers with social/emotional and academic concerns. ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES

Last week the "My Plate check list " included "Be active your way". Find ways to exercise and be active for at least 1 hour a day like walking, riding a bike, or playing a sport. Here are some tips for when you and the kids might be going to the library, walking uptown on High Street, or in your own neighborhood.

TOP SAFETY TIPS WHEN YOU'RE WALKING

If you or your children need to use a cell phone, make sure you stop walking and find a safe area to talk. When using headphones, be sure to look up and pay extra attention and remove the headphones when crossing the street.

Cross streets at corners, using traffic signals and crosswalks. Most injuries happen midblock or someplace other than intersections.

It's always best to walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible.

Look left, right and left again when crossing the street. Teach kids to never run or dart out into the street or cross between parked cars.

Remind yourself and teach your kids to make eye contact with drivers before crossing in front of them and to watch out for cars that are turning or backing up.

Be especially careful at the mall or other shopping centers. Cars sometimes are going or coming across parking lots other than in designated aisles.




