

A Note From Your Former Pastor...


Dear friends in the Lord Jesus -

- to the thousands who sought Our Lord's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and sought His healing through the Anointing of the Sick (in church, on the


- porch, in the street, or in care facility or hospital;


