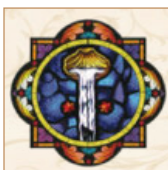
**ANOINTING OF THE SICK**

Dear friends in the Lord Jesus -

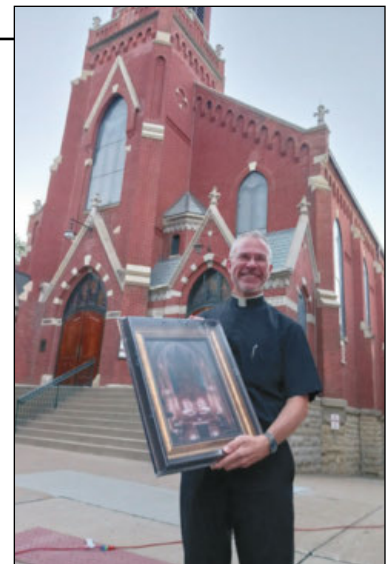
Believe it or not, but I'm finding it to be a challenge to find the right words to express how humbled and grateful I am because of your many kind and gracious notes, cards and calls since the announcement of my departure from St. Peter Parish and School. (Please forgive me for falling behind in sending a thank you note to each of you!)

It has been an honor and a privilege to be your priest and fellow servant of the Lord here at St. Peter for the past four and a half years. During that time we were confronted by many challenges, but I hope that you can recognize that there were many blessings at the same time. I am very appreciative of the dedicated Parish Office and School staff at St. Peter who have lightened the load in so many, many ways. To those who have generously given of your time and expertise on the Parish's Pastoral, Finance, School Advisory, and nascent Stewardship Councils, as well as the Property Committee, I have enjoyed your wise counsel and assistance on so many different topics. Being an imperfect instrument still in need of the Lord's wisdom and mercy, I recognize that you may not have agreed with some of the decisions that I made as your Pastor. To those whom I have offended or have disappointed, I ask for your forgiveness.

- To the 155 new Christians whom I was able to baptize into Our Lord's Mystical Body, His Church;
- to the 214 to whom I was able to offer our Lord Jesus Christ for the first time in Holy Communion;
- to the 34 couples whose union in Holy Matrimony I was privileged to witness;
- to the thousands who sought Our Lord's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation and sought His healing through the Anointing of the Sick (in church, on the

porch, in the street, or in care facility or hospital;

- to the holy memory of the 107 who set aside the worries of this world and whom we commended to Our loving Lord in the Rites of Christian burial - know of my most profound thanks to Almighty God for having been able to be present for all of those uniquely holy sacramental times.



But to all of you, please know that it was a holy joy to celebrate Holy Mass for you thousands of times at the altar (in church...with and without chairs...and for a few months in Selinger Centre). Though I will miss seeing you and sharing in the events of your lives as we have in the past, remember this: it is the Lord Jesus Christ who is the true source of communion and unity, peace and joy in this life and in the next. If we remain in Him, He remains with us always.

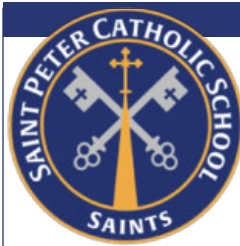
**HELIAS CATHOLIC ALUMNI HOMECOMING EVENT**
