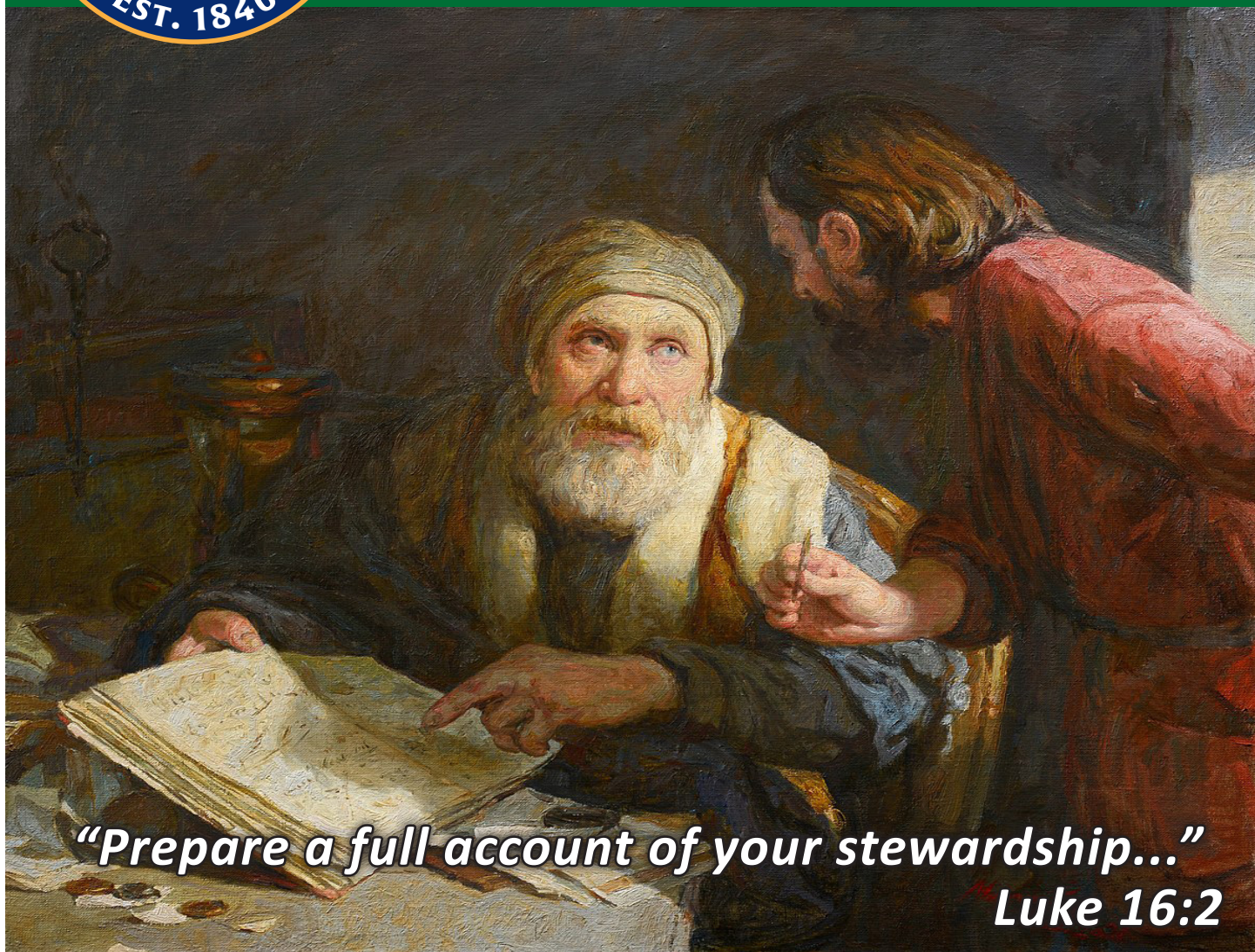

### NEW MONTHLY CATHOLIC FORMATION OPPORTUNITY FOR MEN—SIGNUM CRUCIS

Why Signum Crucis? Signum Crucis is Latin for "Sign of the Cross." This new group will focus on growth in the areas of Study, Devotion, and Service. As we trace the Sign of the Cross on our bodies and pray this most basic prayer, we recognize that we need to seek Study for our Minds, seek Devotion in our Hearts, and to wear our faith gained from Study and Devotion on our sleeves in the form of Service.

This group will strongly encourage men to bring their sons to our monthly gatherings. We know how important it is in our current culture to model our faith to our young people before they leave the fold. Therefore, men are especially requested to bring their sons, nephews, and grandsons who are in high school and grade school. By doing this, adult men will be able to model how to be a true Catholic man by seeking more. This is needed now more than ever.

Monthly gatherings will always be on the third Wednesday of each month, at Helias Catholic High School, from 6:30 p.m. till 8:00 p.m. This timeframe was intentionally set to allow men to get back home in time to help with the family bedtime routine. Our plan is to allow men to choose between attending either a Devotional session or a Study session when we gather, whichever is most needed by each man attending. We might offer a Service opportunity on Wednesday evenings as well. Our Study, Devotion, or Service sessions will last approximately 45-60 minutes, with a wrap-up of our sessions in the Commons, followed by brief fellowship.

Our first gathering will be on September 21. Father Paul Clark, Chaplain of Helias Catholic High School, will offer Mass for us in the Chapel of St. Pius X at Helias at 6:30 p.m. More details about Signum Crucis will be shared after the Mass.

### Holy Matrimony

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and *at least a minimum of six months* prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

### Baptism

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

### Anointing of the Sick

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.

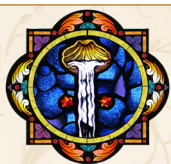

Classes are held Wednesday evenings from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm at St. Peter Catholic School from September 14, 2022 to April 26, 2022.

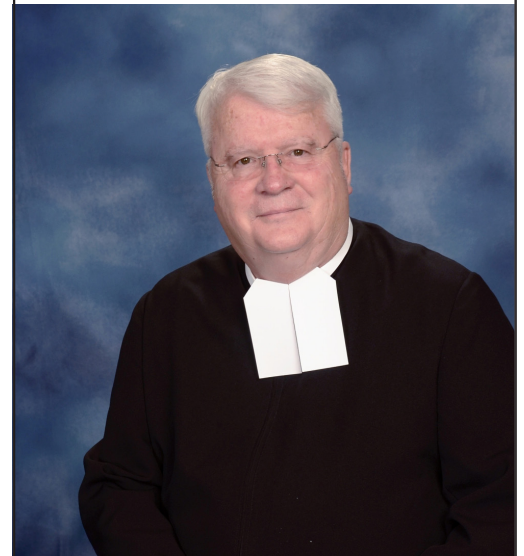
7th grade students and up will be prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

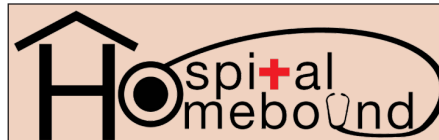
## ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES

## Exercise and You: Part 1

What is exercise and why bother? Well, if we "exercise" and stretch our spiritual faculties through prayer, meditation, read scripture, study our faith, participate in Mass, attend retreats, and other "spiritual exercises" we can be more alive and active spiritually and grow in holiness and be closer to God. Likewise, if we "exercise our mind," with reading, playing board games, playing cards, solving crossword puzzles, learning a language or a musical instrument and other activities that stretch our minds, we help keep our mental faculties active and alive. The third type of exercise and physical activity, where we "exercise our body" can help you stay active and mobile as you age and falls into four basic categories—endurance, strength, balance, and flexibility. Most people tend to focus on one activity or type of exercise and think they're doing enough but each type will give you specific benefits as well as help avoid monotony. The first two categories of exercise are described below and can be applied to all ages.

**Endurance**, or aerobic, activities increase your breathing and heart rate, keeping your heart, lungs, and circulatory system healthy and improving your overall fitness. Building your endurance makes it easier to carry out many of your everyday activities. The NIH suggests brisk walking or jogging, yard work (mowing, raking, digging), sports activities, and dancing; however, check with your health provider regarding the level of intensity you should do.

**Strength** exercises make your muscles stronger. They may help you stay independent and carry out everyday activities, such as climbing stairs and carrying groceries. These exercises also are called "strength training" or "resistance training" and include lifting weights, using a resistance band or using your own body weight such as when you lean against a wall or counter top and push. The "Go4Life" NIA website <https://go4life.nia.nih.gov/exercises> gives examples.
