

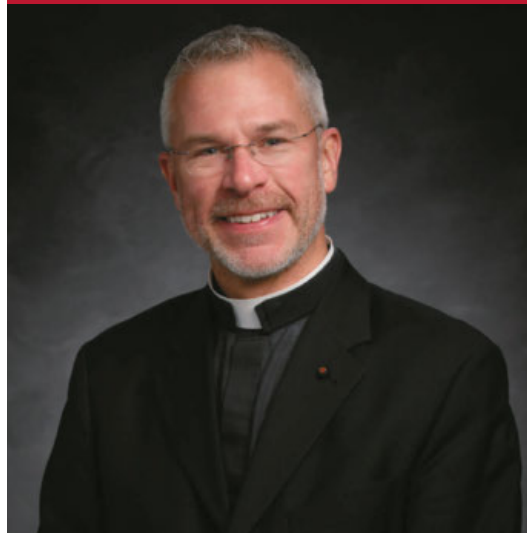


Questions about the Catholic Faith?

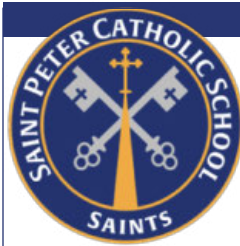
LITTLE SAINTS CARE PROGRAM

Classes are held Wednesday evenings from 7:00 pm to 8:00 pm at St. Peter Catholic School beginning on September 20, 2023.

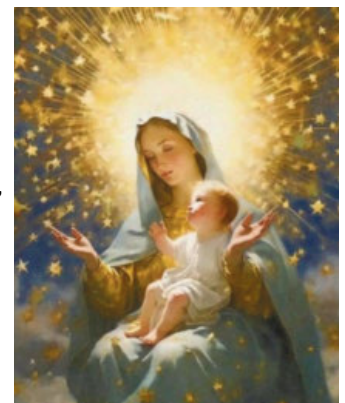
Seventh grade students and up will be prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
