#### **Holy Matrimony**

The first step in planning a wedding at St. Peter is to contact the Pastor. You may call to check available dates beforehand, but the wedding can only be scheduled after approval by the priest and at least a minimum of six months prior to the proposed wedding date. Any Catholic being married needs to have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.

#### **Baptism**

Parental preparation is required for a child to be baptized. Please plan to attend the required class prior to your child's birth. Sessions are usually held once a quarter. Please call the Parish Office to sign up.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

If you are preparing for surgery, please our your priests know before you go to the hospital. Because of COVID-19, the possibility of receiving the Anointing of the Sick after you've been admitted to hospital is not guaranteed.



#### **ALICE KUEHN'S NURSES NOTES**

**SEPTEMBER - A TIME OF NEW BEGINNINGS.** As weather cools, days become filled with school and numerous activities and events. Continue to keep in mind that your total health involves prayer, work, play, healthy eating, good hygiene and a good night's rest.

After School Snacks — Be Safe & Clean up first! Put your books, book bags, and sports equipment on the floor, not on kitchen counters or the table. Germs from your stuff could wind up on the eating surfaces. Wash your hands! Hands carry lots of germs, and not washing is a top cause of food poisoning. This is especially important after greeting our pet, giving it a treat, or even touching its toys or bedding. Always use clean spoons, forks and plates. Wash fruits and veggies with running water before you eat them, even if you plan to peel them. Do not leave cold items - like milk, lunchmeat, hard cooked eggs, or yogurt - out on the counter at room temperature. Put these foods back in the fridge as soon as you've fixed your snack.

Ideas for healthy snacks from each food group (grains, vegetables, fruits, dairy and protein) can be found at http://www.choosemyplate.gov. Some of their suggestions include:

- Fruits apple slices, tangerine sections, strawberry halves, bananas, pineapple, kiwi, peach, mango, nectarine, melon, grapes, berries, dried apricots
- Dairy low-fat cheese slices or string cheese, mini yogurt cups, fat-free or low-fat milk, low-fat cottage cheese.
- Protein suggestions include slices or wedges, peanut butter, bean dip, hummus, slices of lean turkey or chicken, and shelled pumpkin seeds. Food Safety Tips for Preschoolers can be found at the same site as well.






