


RESTORATION OF THE INTERIOR OF ST. PETER CHURCH


CURSILLO PILGRIMAGE TO PERRYVILLE



ALICE KUEHN'S NURSE NOTES

With the release of Pope Francis' encyclical on ecology, June 18th, 2015, the Catholic Church brought a fresh and distinctive perspective to the discussion of environmental questions, stressing the moral dimensions of these issues and the needs of the most vulnerable. Pope Francis speaks about something called "integral ecology." This idea tells us that the way we relate with one another and how we relate to the environment are intimately connected. Integral ecology means that "natural ecology"—the environment, our natural resources, the precious gift of Creation—is firmly linked to "human ecology"—how we respect life, treat one another, regard the poor, structure our economic decisions and policy, mold and shape our society.

The USCCB web page on environment also mentions the Environmental Justice Program (EJP), a program of the Catholic Campaign for Human Development, which is responsible for both educating and motivating Catholics to a deeper reverence and respect for God's creation, encouraging Catholics to address environmental problems.


