

St. Peter Parish Wedding Liaison

St. Peter Parish utilizes a Wedding Liaison to assist couples in the preparation of their wedding and to assist with all the details within the church. The Parish Wedding Liaison shares in a couple's festive day. Working with the bridal couple, the Liaison ensures the church is open, makes the wedding party feel welcome, assists the bride before the wedding, facilitates the procession and helps liturgies flow smoothly. They accommodate any special requirements from the Priest and help with the rehearsal the evening before the wedding. The Priest often does not have time to cover all the details regarding a wedding.

The Wedding Liaison provides guidance on the proper etiquette in the Church, the location of furniture, candelabras, lighting and dressing rooms. The service of a Wedding Liaison is required for all weddings held at St. Peter Church.

The fee for this service is \$150. However, for a small wedding a smaller fee may be negotiated.

The Wedding Liaison Will:

Be available for in-person consultation prior to the wedding to make appropriate plans and answer questions and then by telephone or email as needed.

Be present during the rehearsal to help organize the wedding party and assist with the rehearsal.

Be present the day of the wedding to unlock the church, the choir loft and dressing room, and to turn on the lights.

Be present to receive floral deliveries and assist the photographer and / or videographer.

Set up the Church to include: kneelers, unity candle, candelabras, etc., as needed.

Prepare sacred vessels and other items needed for the Wedding Mass.

As wedding begins, help ensure that parents and bridal party process down the aisle in proper order and during the correct music selection.

After the wedding, help remove all wedding candles, wedding flowers and decorations.

Remove all programs, boxes and other leftovers from pews and floor, taking them to the Parish Office.

Return the church to proper order.

Check dressing rooms and lock appropriate doors.

The Wedding Liaison Will Not:

Set your rehearsal date/time nor your wedding date/time with the Priest or Business Manager.

Decorate Selinger Center or any other location for your reception.

Plan the music for your Wedding Liturgy.

Clean the dressing room.
